## CHARACTERISTICS

All displayed stones are natural materials, each possessing unique characteristics, ensuring that no two pieces are identical. Variations in color, pattern, and overall appearance are inherent to these products. As naturally occurring materials, they may exhibit fine surface lines and minor pits, which do not compromise their functionality or quality. The images provided are for reference purposes only. **MARBLE** — is a timeless and elegant stone known for its distinctive veining and luxurious appeal. Formed through the metamorphosis of limestone, it is available in a wide range of colors and patterns, making it a versatile choice for both classic and contemporary designs. While durable, marble is naturally porous and benefits from proper care to maintain its pristine appearance.

**ONYX** — is a striking, translucent stone prized for its dramatic color variations and unique layering. Often used in decorative applications such as feature walls, lighting, and statement pieces, onyx creates a stunning visual effect, especially when backlit. Due to its delicate nature, it requires careful handling and regular maintenance.

**TRAVERTINE** — is a type of limestone characterized by its porous surface and earthy tones. It offers a naturally textured look and can be used in both rustic and modern designs. Travertine can be supplied in **filled** or **unfilled** form, depending on the desired finish and application.

## FINISHES & SURFACE TREATMENTS

Our materials can be produced in two different finishes: **glossy**, which has a reflective shine, and **honed (matte)**, which offers a smooth, non-reflective surface.

A **GLOSSY FINISH** enhances the stone's colors and veining with a reflective, polished surface, creating a luxurious and elegant look. It is ideal for areas where a high-end aesthetic is desired, such as statement furniture pieces, feature walls, or decorative surfaces. However, polished surfaces may require regular care to maintain their shine and are more susceptible to showing fingerprints and water spots.

A **HONED FINISH** offers a smooth, matte surface with a softer, more natural appearance, making it ideal for a subtle and contemporary aesthetic. This finish is particularly suited for high-traffic areas, as it is more resistant to scratches and etching, making it a practical choice for worktops, flooring, and bathroom applications.

## Travertine: Filled & Unfilled Options

Travertine, known for its naturally porous structure, can be treated in two different ways to enhance its durability and appearance:

**FILLED TRAVERTINE** — The stone's natural holes are filled with resin or cement, resulting in a smoother, more uniform surface. This enhances durability and makes it ideal for flooring, countertops, and other functional surfaces where a refined look is desired.

**UNFILLED TRAVERTINE** — Maintains its organic, textured character with visible natural cavities, offering a more rustic and raw aesthetic. This option is perfect for decorative applications and areas where an authentic, natural stone look is preferred. Over time, unfilled travertine may develop a patina, further enhancing its unique appeal.

### Caring for Natural Stone

Protecting natural stone — whether marble, onyx, or travertine — is essential. While durable enough to withstand weight and impact, it can lose its beauty if scratched or if dirt accumulates.

Regular cleaning is key to maintaining its elegance. A simple wipe with a cloth prevents dust, dirt, and soap scum (especially in bathrooms) from becoming stubborn stains. For routine care, water is usually enough, but be sure to dry the surface to avoid stagnant pools.

For a deeper clean, use specialized stone care products — just remember to rinse thoroughly to prevent detergent buildup, which can create dull spots. Always dry the surface afterward for the best results.

## CARE & MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning Products for Natural Stone

Selecting the right cleaning products is crucial for maintaining natural stone. While water is sufficient for daily cleaning, using a pH-neutral detergent helps keep the surface spotless without causing damage. Specialized stone cleaners are ideal, as they prevent corrosion and unsightly marks.

Always read and follow the product instructions, including dilution and application guidelines.

### What to Avoid:

**ACIDIC SUBSTANCES & STRONG PIGMENTS** — Marble is sensitive to items like lemon juice, vinegar, tomato sauce, beetroot, and turmeric. Wipe spills immediately to prevent staining.

**LINGERING LIQUIDS** — Water, wine, coffee, and similar substances can be absorbed by marble, leading to stains — clean them up promptly.

**IMPACT DAMAGE** — Dropping marble items may cause cracks or chips. Handle with care to maintain their integrity and appearance.

### Removing Stains and Stubborn Dirt

Keeping your stone accessories and furniture in top condition means knowing how to tackle stains and dirt effectively.

Since natural stone is absorbent, it's important to act quickly to prevent substances like wine, oil, or coffee from seeping in. A simple wipe with water and a soft cloth is usually enough for fresh spills.

However, if a stain goes unnoticed for days or weeks, a specialized stone cleaner may be needed to restore the surface. The right products can effectively lift stains while preserving the stone's natural beauty.
